



OUR HISTORY

2008

Seven women meet to address gun violence in nearby housing community. With a \$500 grant from the Eastport Civic Association, Eastport Girls Club (EGC), the tutoring program is formed.

2010

Mentoring component is added to the Eastport Girls Club tutoring program to provide additional support to youth by pairing each with a one-on-one mentor.

2011

EGC incorporates as Seeds 4 Success (S4S) and receives 501(c)(3) status.

Parent Workshops added to expand services to parent/guardians of youth served.

2012

I Am a Reader program is added to help low-income 1st and 2nd grade boys increase reading ability and comprehension.

2015

Summer programming added to serve all youth in programs.

College and Career Access Program (ACEC) added to expand services to high school students from 9th to 12th grade.

2018

Eastport Boys Club (EBC) program is created to replace I Am a Reader. and run parallel to EGC program.
